**Judge Orientation Guidelines  
Computer Build & Presentation Session**

1. Report to N1-405 at Mission College - to sign-in, obtain your judge packet & meet your partner.

**POC's:** Allan Quan, StRUT, Rich Monroe: Independent, Industry

2. Judges are paired, one each from education & industry. Each judge team will judge one team of three students during each session.

3. Session Venues (3): Sorenson Hall – Written Test; N1-405 – Challenge; Center Space – Computer Build & Presentation

4. There will be two separate Computer Build & Presentation Sessions, one from 9:30 – 11:00 am & one from 11:15 am – 12:45 pm. The Computer Build & Presentation Session will be held in the Main Building – Center Space.

5. The judge role is as follows:

- ⇒ Act as an observer of the team & judge how well they perform according to the Rubric forms, relevant to the two parts of the session – build/diagnostics & presentation.
- ⇒ Do not prompt or coach the students. Each team is responsible to complete the build/diagnostics, prepare & give a presentation within the allotted time – 1.5 hours.
- ⇒ Complete the rubric forms provided for the Build & Presentation & sign them. Turn in a Master consolidated score for each rubric/team judged.
- ⇒ (Exception: more help will be offered to Elementary students if needed.)

6. Each team should have designated a “team captain”. In case there is a malfunction with the computer, the team captain should report it to one of the judges. The judge in turn reports it the Head Tech – Robert Guest.

7. If a student is performing an “unsafe” activity, the judge should stop the student **immediately** (see the safety guidelines in the judge packet). The team will be TIME penalized for this stoppage.

8. During the presentation part of the session, it is encouraged that the judges sit in chairs provided, to make it more formal.

9. Presentations can be given using either hard copy pictures or the presentation application & grade level clip art pre-loaded on their computer. NO prepared presentations will be accepted. (Exception: more help will be offered to Elementary students if needed.)

10. **At the end of each session, promptly** return the completed rubric grade forms to the POC.

11. Following the first student build session, the computers will be turned off & left for the next session.
